1.) What can be done to reduce the carbon footprint of your school district?

3.) What do you consider to be the ideal class size and why?
4.) What steps need to be taken to make every student feel safe and provided for in our schools?
5.) There is a shortage of Special Education teachers and teachers of English Language Learners. How would you address this shortage?
6.) From an equity standpoint, how do you feel about the current way that public schools in Washington State are funded?
7.) What qualities do you consider most desirable in a Superintendent?
8.) Describe what measures are currently undertaken in your district to assist those students with disabilities. What, if anything, can be improved?
9.) What steps can be taken to ensure that students make the best nutritional choices both on school grounds and off school grounds?
10.) What infrastructure changes can be implemented to improve school safety?
11.) What do you plan to do to eliminate racism, homophobia, and other hate speech at school?

- 12.) The pandemic forced drastic alterations in how education was delivered. What "tactics" should be carried forward into the post-pandemic educational environment? What did you learn from the pandemic experience and what would you change if it occurred again?
